
A historic place who welcomed the greatest fashion photographers since the 60s

The emblematic Acacias Art Center which today houses the Reiffers Initiatives was, in the 1960s, a mecca of creation for the greatest French and international photographers.

In the 1960s, photographers Richard Avedon, Guy Bourdin, Irving Penn and Francis Giacobetti were accustomed to there and took legendary photos.

In the 90s, the famous Studio Harcourt moved there and carried out the shootings of many personalities.


In 2013, the studio was completely renovated and joined the Mazarine group under the leadership of Paul-Emmanuel Reiffers. It thus rediscovers its artistic vocation by hosting exhibitions by French and international artists.



A place located in the heart of Paris under the Étoile

Near the Étoile district, Reiffers Initiatives - L'Acacias Art Center is located in the emblematic Parisian Golden Triangle, epicenter of luxury and new nerve center of contemporary art.



Reiffers Initiatives - The Acacias Art Center is a unique and rare setting, close to the Arc de Triomphe and a few steps from the bustling Matignon Saint-Honoré district, the new golden triangle of contemporary art and a favorite place for international art galleries setting up in Paris.

It is also close to the essential cultural institutions of Western Paris such as the Louis Vuitton Foundation, the Paris Museum of Modern Art and the Palais de Tokyo.






A museum-sized exhibition platform







A floor under the Paris sky



A space of 600m²

Reception area at the entrance:

- A large bay window overlooking Rue des Acacias
- Surface area of 100 m² with its tunnel which leads to the historic spaces of the place

Ground floor:

- A large 250 m² platform with a ceiling height of 4 meters, ideal for hosting conferences.
- A fully fitted kitchen of 30 m²

Ceiling height 7m under glass roof


First floor:

- A large 150 m² platform bathed in light
- A 15 m² dressing room
- A beautiful ceiling height of 7 meters and its glass roof: an ideal space for organizing meetings, shootings with natural lighting and cocktail dinners.

- A large storage space of 100 m²







Cutting plane of the building



Plan from the ground floor




Plan from the first floor
